- The Owner shall comply with the requirements of the legislation and Australian Standards set out below (and any amendments or replacements to any of them):
 - Plumbing Code of Australia 2011 in particular;
 - AS/NZ 3500.1:2003-National Plumbing and Drainage, Part 1.2 water supply and
 - AS 2845:2010-Water Supply - Mechanical Backflow Prevention Devices (BPD)
- The Owner shall ensure that any Backflow Prevention Device (BPD) installed on the property complies with and is identified as complying with AS 2845:2010.

Please note:

The owner is also responsible for maintaining the potable water supply inside the property. Depending on the plumbing system and hazard ratings of the internal processes, you may wish to consider whether you need to install additional individual and / or zone protection backflow prevention devices, apart from the containment device at the property boundary.

Maintenance and Testing

- In accordance with AS/NZ 3500.1.2:2003 you will need to ensure the BPD at the property boundary is:
 - installed by a person accredited for installation, commissioning and testing of backflow prevention devices;
 - installed so that access is available for inspection and servicing and so that freezing cannot occur;
 - installed in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions;
 - commissioned by an approved person at the time of installation and before opening onto downstream systems to ensure the device functions satisfactorily; and
 - tested by an approved person, at intervals of not more than 12 months in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions and the requirements of AS 2845:2010.

Copies of commissioning details and yearly test results **must** be forwarded to Western Water as a condition of supply.

You should also keep a Test and Maintenance Report Log which may be inspected by a Western Water representative.
